**WHEREAS** the Academic Senate, at its meeting of 24.10.2024, expressed its favourable opinion on the three-year plan established by the Departments, including that of the Department of Medical Sciences and Public Health, in which the actuating of a position of Professor of first or second level for GSD (scientific-disciplinary group) 06/MEDS-01 - Medical Genetics (SSD academic discipline

MEDS-01/A - Medical Genetics) has been agreed on, to be filled by mobility by call pursuant to Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater, of Law No. 240/2010;

**WHEREAS**

the Board of Directors, in its meeting of 24.10.2024, approved the three-year plan established by the Departments, including that of the Department of Medical Sciences and Public Health, in which the actuating of a position of professors of first or second level for GSD (scientific-disciplinary group) 06/MEDS-01 - Medical Genetics (SSD academic discipline MEDS-01/A - Medical Genetics) has been agreed on, to be filled through mobility by call ex art. 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater, of Law No. 240/2010;

**HAVING REGARDS TO** the resolution of 19.02.2025, by which the Department of Medical Sciences and Public Health, pursuant to Article 3 of the Regulation governing mobility through direct call of professors under Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater of Law no. 240/2010, sets out the specific teaching, research, or third mission requirements to be addressed in the project proposal to be submitted by candidates applying for the position;

**HAVING REGARDS TO** the resolution of 23.06.2025, by which the Department of Pedagogy, Psychology, Philosophy approved a change in planning by converting a request for an RTT Researcher position into a mobility procedure for the direct call of an Associate Professor for the Scientific Disciplinary Group 14/GSPS-06 – Sociology of Cultural and Communication Processes (SSD GSPS-06/A – Sociology of Cultural and Communication Processes), and by which it also specified, pursuant to Article 3 of the Regulation governing the mobility by direct call of professors under Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater of Law no. 240/2010, the specific teaching, research, or third mission requirements to be addressed in the project proposal to be submitted by candidates applying for the position;

**WHEREAS**

the Academic Senate, in its meeting of 24.07.2025, gave a favourable opinion on the amendment to the three-year planning approved by the Departments, including that of the Department of Pedagogy, Psychology, Philosophy, which includes the activation of a position for an Associate Professor in the Scientific Disciplinary Group 14/GSPS-06 – Sociology of Cultural and Communication Processes (SSD GSPS-06/A – Sociology of Cultural and Communication Processes), to be filled through a mobility procedure by direct call pursuant to Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater of Law no. 240/2010;

**WHEREAS**

the Board of Directors, in its meeting of 25.07.2025, approved the amendment to the three-year planning resolved by the Departments,

including that of the Department of Pedagogy, Psychology, Philosophy, which provides for the activation of a position for an Associate Professor in the Scientific Disciplinary Group 14/GSPS-06 – Sociology of Cultural and Communication Processes (SSD GSPS-06/A – Sociology of Cultural and Communication Processes), to be filled through a mobility procedure by direct call pursuant to Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater of Law no. 240/2010;

**TAKING INTO ACCOUNT** that the procedure governed by this call is in line with the University's "Human Resources Excellence in Research" strategy for implementing the principles of the European Charter for Researchers, with the aim of promoting an attractive research environment, particularly for "Leading Researchers" (R4), through a comparative assessment of candidates, in accordance with the standards for Open, Transparent and Merit-based Recruitment (OTM-R).

#### ISSUES THE FOLLOWING DECREE

##### ART. 1

##### **(Mobility procedure for appointing 2 associate professors)**

This University has announced, pursuant to Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater of Law 240/2010 and the "Regulations governing the mobility by call of professors pursuant to Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater, of Law No. 240/2010", the following mobility procedures for the appointment of 2 associate professors.

## ART. 2

### (Admission requirements)

The mobility procedure by appointment referred to in Article 1 is open, without restrictions regarding citizenship, to candidates who are:

a) Associate professors who have been employed for at least five years at other universities in the same Scientific-Disciplinary Group as the one procedure in which they intend to participate;

b) academics who are permanently resident abroad for research or teaching purposes and who have held an academic position equivalent to that of associate professor in foreign universities for at least five years, on the basis of the equivalence tables established by [Ministerial Decree No. 456 of 10 May 2023](#), in sectors falling within the subject areas of the GSD (scientific-disciplinary group) as the one procedure in which they intend to participate;

c) Research directors and principal investigators at public research institutions, who have been employed at their respective institutions for at least five years and who hold the National Scientific Qualification for Level II for the competitive sector corresponding, pursuant to Table B of DM 639/2024, to the Scientific-Disciplinary Group as the one procedure in which they intend to participate. The eligibility obtained pursuant to Law No. 210 of July 3, 1998, is considered equivalent to the National Scientific Qualification solely for the duration of its validity;

d) Individuals employed in permanent positions, or on fixed-term contracts pursuant to Article 1, paragraph 422 and following of Law No. 205 of 27 December 2017, at the Scientific Hospitalization and Care Institutes (IRCCS) who carry out translational, preclinical, and clinical research, having been in service at their institution for at least five years and holding the National Scientific Qualification for Level II for the corresponding competitive sector pursuant to Table B of DM 639/2024, corresponding to the Scientific-Disciplinary Group 06/MEDS-01. The eligibility obtained pursuant to Law No. 210 of July 3, 1998, is considered equivalent to the National Scientific Qualification solely for the duration of its validity.

Candidates will be excluded from the call procedure if, on the date of expiry of the deadline for submission of applications, they:

- have been barred from the enjoyment of their civil and political rights;
- have been dismissed from public service for persistent incompetence or have been declared ineligible to hold any other public office pursuant to Article 127(d) of Presidential Decree No. 3 of 10 January 1957;
- are related, by marriage or affinity up to and including the fourth degree, to a professor or associate professor of the department applying for the post, or to the Rector, or to the



Director General, or to one or more members of the Board of Directors of the University, or are themselves members of the Board of Directors.

Exclusion from the procedure may be ordered at any time, even after the evaluation has taken place, by reasoned decree of the Rector notified to the person concerned.

This administration guarantees equality and equal opportunities between men and women in access to employment and treatment at work.

### ART. 3

#### (Submission of expression of interest)

The expression of interest for the call, drafted according to the attached template (Annex "A"), along with the project proposal that the candidate intends to develop in line with the teaching, research, or third mission needs indicated in the notice (Annex "B"), the curriculum vitae of their teaching and scientific activities, any additional qualifications, and publications, must be submitted—under penalty of exclusion—by the fifteenth day, starting from the day following the publication of this notice, using the following methods:

- Submission of the expression of interest and the related attachments (**excluding publications**) from your certified email account (PEC) to the address [protocollo@pec.unica.it](mailto:protocollo@pec.unica.it)
- Submission of the **publications** from your certified email account (PEC) to the address [concorsi@pec.unica.it](mailto:concorsi@pec.unica.it).

The expression of interest for the call (Annex "A") must be fully completed, and the following documents must be attached:

- a scan of a valid identification document and the tax code. non-european citizens must provide a scan of their valid passport.
- the project proposal that the candidate intends to develop in line with the teaching, research, or third mission requirements indicated in the notice (annex "b").
- the signed curriculum vitae of the candidate's teaching and scientific activities.
- the signed and numbered list of the attached scientific publications.
- the scientific publications and/or any additional qualifications the candidate wishes to submit for the procedure.
- a certificate of service rendered at the foreign university, indicating the academic position held (only for academics based abroad engaged in research or teaching activities).

No other forms of submission for expressions of interest or supporting documents for participation in the procedure are permitted.

In the expression of interest for the call, candidates must clearly indicate their last name and first name, date and place of birth, and tax code. Married women must indicate their maiden name.

Candidates must also declare under their own responsibility:





- 1) Their residence and domicile;
- 2) Their nationality;
- 3) That they have not been convicted of any criminal offences, or if they have been convicted of any offences, indicate the details of the judicial sentences, and any criminal proceedings pending against them;
- 4) That are not related, by blood or by affinity up to the fourth degree, to a tenured professor of the department applying for the position, to the Rector, to the Director General, or to a member of the Board of Directors of the University, or that they are not themselves member of the Board of Directors;
- 5) That they have not been dismissed from the public service for persistent inadequate performance and have not been declared ineligible for public office pursuant to Article 127, letter d) of Presidential Decree No. 3 of 10.01.1957;
- 6) They are registered on an electoral roll, indicating the municipality and, if applicable, the reasons for non-registration or cancellation; candidates who are nationals of foreign States must declare that they enjoy civil and political rights in the States to which they belong or from which they come, or the reasons why they do not;
- 7) That they meet one of the requirements set out in Article 2, paragraph 1, for participation in the call procedure;
- 8) to authorise the University of Cagliari's Teaching Staff Recruitment Sector to send him/her communications relating to the selection process exclusively by means of the certified e-mail address indicated in the application, and to promptly notify any change thereof;
- 9) That they have read the information notice on data processing by the University of Cagliari for the category 'Citizens', published on the website [https://www.unica.it/unica/it/utility\\_privacy.page](https://www.unica.it/unica/it/utility_privacy.page).

The omission of even one of the above declarations will result in exclusion from the procedure. All communications between the Faculty Recruitment Office and candidates will take place exclusively via certified email (PEC).

The University assumes no responsibility in cases where the recipient is unreachable, for the loss of communications due to incorrect indication of the PEC address by the candidate, or for failure or delay in notifying changes to the certified email address provided in the expression of interest.

Submitting an application as an expression of interest does not, in any case, grant the right to admission to the recruitment procedures for faculty positions at this University.

#### **ART. 4**

##### **(Presentation of academic publications and curriculum)**

In the case of publications published abroad, the following details must be provided where possible: the date and place of publication or, alternatively, the ISBN code or other equivalent. For publications published in Italy, prior to 2 September 2006, the obligations must be fulfilled in accordance with the forms provided for by art. 1 of Lieutenant's Decree No. 660 of 31 August 1945; as of 2 September 2006, the obligations must be fulfilled in accordance with the forms provided for by Law No. 106 of 15 April 2004 and the relative regulation issued by Presidential Decree No. 252 of 3 May 2006, by the date of the deadline of the selection notice.



Publications sent after the deadline for submitting applications will not be taken into consideration.

Publications submitted after the deadline for expressing interest in the procedure will not be considered.

Non-EU citizens may use the declaration in lieu of certification or an affidavit, limited to cases in which they are required to prove statements, facts and qualities that can be certified or attested to by Italian public or private entities.

The certificates issued by the competent authorities of the non-EU State of which the foreigner is a national must comply with the provisions in force in that State and must also be authenticated by the competent Italian consular authorities.

The administration will carry out appropriate checks on the accuracy of the content of the substitute declarations.

Documents not attached because they have already been submitted to this or another administration and referred to in the application will not be considered.

#### **ART. 5**

##### **(Exclusion from the procedure)**

Candidates are admitted to the call procedure with reservations. The Rector may exclude them at any time by means of a motivated decree.

#### **ART. 6**

##### **(Selection Committee)**

The Selection Committees, one for each individual selection, will be composed of three full professors, belonging to the Scientific-disciplinary Group for which the procedure has been initiated, identified in accordance with the procedures set out in Article 7 of the *Regulation governing the mobility of professors by call, pursuant to Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater of Law No. 240/2010*.

Professors who are currently members of the Board of Directors and the Academic Senate of this university may not be appointed to the committees. Professors belonging to the same university may not be members of the Committee. Any member of the Committee who finds him/herself in such a situation of incompatibility must resign and inform the University immediately.

At the end of the application period, the Rector will formally appoint the selection committee. The Rector's decree appointing the committee will be published on the University's website in the recruitment section.

Candidates will be informed of this publication.

Participation in the work of the Committee is mandatory for its members, except for justified and documented reasons.



## **ART. 7**

### **(Work of the Committee)**

The first meeting of the Selection Committee shall be convened by the Internal Committee Member after consultation with the full Committee. At its first meeting, the Selection Committee shall elect a Chairperson and a minutes Secretary.

The Committee shall be collegial in its work and shall take decisions by absolute majority, which may include the use of telematic tools for collegial work. In this case, the Committee shall carry out its work collegially, adopting its decisions by absolute majority, and may use telematic means for meetings. In such case, the Committee must adopt tools and measures suitable to ensure the transparency of the procedures and equal treatment of the candidates, and must guarantee the highest possible confidentiality of communications.

The evaluation is carried out on the basis of the following general criteria:

- a) congruence and relevance of the project proposal with the Scientific-Disciplinary Group and the academic discipline, as well as relevance to the contents of the teaching and/or research and/or Third Mission requirements indicated in the notice;
- b) level of academic qualifications and competence already acquired by the candidate in the disciplinary fields indicated in the notice, documented by his/her curriculum, academic production and qualifications presented, as well as their congruence and appropriateness with the project proposal submitted;
- c) clarity, comprehensiveness and integrity of the project proposal submitted, specifically in terms of its impact on the Department's needs as indicated in the notice.

At the conclusion of its work, the Commission, by a reasoned decision adopted by a majority of its members, evaluates each expression of interest received based on the above criteria and identifies the one that best meets the Department's needs as specified in the announcement. In the event that there is only one candidate to be assessed, the Committee may make a judgement as to suitability/unsuitability for the post.

The Committee shall complete its work within two months of the Rector's decision on the appointment.

The records shall consist of the minutes of each meeting, of which the collective judgement of the Committee on each candidate and the final summary report shall be an integral part. In the event of disagreement between one or more members of the Committee on the evaluation of candidates, such disagreement may be expressed in a minority report.

## **ART. 8**

### **(Verification of the validity of documents)**

Within fifteen days of delivery to the Offices, the Rector ascertains the formal validity of the documents and shall approve them by decree or, if he finds irregularities in the selection procedure, he shall return them to the Committee by means of a justified decision, setting a deadline for the Committee to make any necessary corrections.

The decree approving the documents will be published on the University's website at <https://personale.unica.it/docric/public/> and the candidates as well as the relevant Department will be informed of the publication..

Applicants will be notified of these publications.

#### **ART. 9**

##### **(Appointment of the most qualified candidate)**

At the end of the selection procedure, within 30 days of receipt of the Rector's decree approving the Committee's actions, the Department shall submit to the Board a proposal for the appointment of the candidate who has submitted the expression of interest which the Committee considers to best meet the Department's needs as set out in the call for applications, or of the candidate who has obtained a positive assessment in the case of a single expression of interest.

The decision to call for applications is taken by an absolute majority of the eligible full professors.

The Council of the Department concerned may decide, giving reasons, not to proceed with the call if none of the project proposals submitted meets the specific teaching, research and/or Third Mission requirements for which the call was issued.

After receiving the opinion of the Academic Senate, the call will be submitted for approval to the Board of Directors, which will decide within thirty days.

The call proposal may also be formulated directly by the Academic Senate, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors, which shall decide within thirty days

#### **ART. 10**

##### **(Formal documentation and appointment of the successful candidate)**

In order to verify that he/she fulfils the eligibility requirements, the successful candidate must submit to this administration, within a mandatory period of thirty days from the day following the effective date of his/her recruitment, the documents required by the regulations in force. Appointment as an associate professor at this University shall be made by decree of the Rector and shall take effect in accordance with the legislation in force.

Appointed associate professors shall be entitled to the remuneration and social security benefits provided for by the legislation in force.

The provisions of Article 6 of Law 240/2010, which regulates the legal status of tenured professors, apply to the appointed associate professor.

The performance of extra-institutional assignments is governed by the "University Regulations for the Authorisation of Extra-institutional Assignments by Lecturers and Researchers".

#### **ART. 11**



**(Person in charge of the procedure)**

In accordance with Article 5 of Law No. 241 of 7 August 1990, Dr. Enrico Gioffrè, Head of the University's Teaching Staff Recruitment Sector- tel. 070/6752347 - e-mail [concorsidoc@unica.it](mailto:concorsidoc@unica.it), has been appointed as the person responsible for the procedure, who will ensure that the full procedure is carried out correctly, in accordance with the regulations in force, and that the candidates are informed.

Media consumption, informational experiences, and political participation are deeply intertwined phenomena: individuals not only receive information, but also contribute to the public arena through cultural practices such as sharing, commenting, and content creation. In this perspective, media literacy, the emotional dimension of informational experiences, and critical reflexivity play a key role in determining whether access to information leads to political engagement or remains a passive form of consumption.</p>			



The Department needs to further develop this line of research, in collaboration with areas related to political philosophy, philosophy of language, moral philosophy, as well as psychological and sociological disciplines.
